## SEMINAR OVERVIEW

Food Safety is of utmost importance to the meat industry that must be addressed using a multifaceted approach. Good Manufacturing Practices, Sanitation Standard Operating Procedures and HACCP are all parts of an effective Food Safety program. From time to time it is important to revisit critical aspects of Food Safety such as sanitation to make sure they are working as effectively as possible. It is also worthy to know how looking beyond the regulatory requirements of sanitation can provide you with great benefits. We will also learn about technologies that are available to improve your food safety program and likely make your life easier.

The University of Wisconsin Meat Science Extension, the Meat Safety and Inspection Bureau of the Wisconsin DATCP, and the Wisconsin Association of Meat Processors are co-sponsoring seminars to discuss tips, tricks and technologies available to 1) strengthen your HACCP system and 2) make your Food Safety program more user friendly and efficient.
